Mission

The VHS International bursary ensures that VHS courses are accessible across a wide geographical and socio-economic range of students.

Vision

To encourage motivated, students who are non-residents of Canada to take courses with VHS wherever they are located, despite their financial background. This Bursary Program goes beyond simply helping a student with tuition fees, as VHS hopes to further assist any student who is a non-resident of Canada with their future educational goals whether that be internationally or within Canada.

Goal

The goal of the International Student Bursary is to support students who are non-residents of Canada with the opportunity to receive high-quality online education to assist in achieving global academic goals and aspirations.

Important Bursary Information

- The International Student Bursary is issued *six* times per calendar year – January, March, May, July, September and November.
- *One* candidate will be chosen each submission period to receive this award.
- Students granted the bursary will receive full tuition for one standard Virtual High School course, **including** applicable International student fee (Fast Track courses are not included).
- This bursary is *non-transferable*, and successful applicants must utilize the bursary *within* 90 days of the date of issuance.
- A student may receive this bursary *once* per calendar year.
- A student visa is not required to take courses with Virtual High School.
- Additional fees *may* apply, including an Equivalent Credit Assessment etc. This bursary covers the base tuition price plus international student fee (\$814 CDN) only.

Students who wish to be considered for the International Student Bursary must submit a completed application along with all supporting documentations to VHS.Awards@vhs.ucourses.com on or before the 15th of the month in which the bursary will be granted. The Awards Selection Committee will convene to review all applicants. Once the recipient has been selected, all applicants will be contacted no later than the 25th of the month.

Application Process: When submitting your International Student Bursary application package to VHS.Awards@vhs.ucourses.com, please be sure to include the following:

- Most recent Notice of Assessment (or equivalent tax documents from home country) OR Pay stub(s) in domestic currency, in English or translated to English
- Application form, to be completed by the applicant, in English
- High School Transcript or current academic progress from home country
- Government Issued Identification (ID)
